



Connecting siloed systems together

Global manufacturer unifies its business with our Azure solution



EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Our client, Vacuum Technique Group, a subsidiary of global industrial conglomerate Atlas Copco, manufactures industrial-sized vacuum pumps. They wanted to connect siloed areas of their business together using bespoke APIs and Microsoft Azure Logic apps.

As a result, we saved them more than £400,000 in software vendor costs with a Microsoft Azure connection solution. We were able to unify their disparate systems together so data flowed freely between teams.



THE RESULTS

We saved them £400,000 by investing in our work to utilize Microsoft Azure services instead of renewing their software vendor contract. There were 250 successful runs of the bespoke API-based solution for password reset helpdesk tickets in May 2022. Before this, each ticket would've required a Support Analyst to manually reset passwords for users.

Thanks to our modern Azure connection solution, this is no longer the case and saved a lot of time for support staff.



THE CHALLENGE

Due to several acquisitions of smaller vacuums pump businesses, they had a portfolio of siloed, inherited systems housing legacy systems. They were unable to easily access data or connect data together across the organisation.

They needed a digital transformation and systems integration expert to implement a solution that would link everything together. This would ensure that data would flow as intended across their business areas and teams.

They were also facing a £400,000 3-year contract with their previous software vendor which they wanted to reduce.
